In his debut exhibition, Mark Slankard presents a series of photographs taken in Turkey over the past few years that show the clashes in time and culture, where the old ways meet the 21st Century. Istanbul is the meeting of the East and West, and Turkey is a place where you will find ancient ruins and high rises. Slankard has spent time documenting the borders of the 'old world' and its people and traditions next to the rising middle class and expanding suburbs. Following his long-standing interest in the cultural landscape of residential areas, Slankard reveals people and their homes, from shanties to high rises, with sheep grazing next to new towers and cows wandering about downtown. In some photographs, it is hard to distinguish between what is an old ruin and what is new construction in progress.

'Your Ad Here' features new paintings and drawings by Karla Wozniak depicting American commercial and suburban landscapes in transition. These new paintings are monumental representations of small places. 'Clarion, PA' is a hilly area with a commercial center off the freeway and far from urban areas. Wozniak's images come from photographs taken by her on road trips, which she then transforms in the studio into poetic portraits of overlooked places. As cynics often call anyone living between NYC and LA 'people we fly over', these are similarly unheralded places 'we drive by'. It is Wozniak's combination of quietly compelling subjects and an intelligent and purposeful process that gives her a unique voice in the cacophony of the contemporary art world.
